



Purpose : To provide support to students who have difficulty with written or spoken English.

Focus: The program provides support in the English language to help the students succeed in academic areas

Eligibility: Students are identified for this support through the Home Language Survey and W-APT/ACCESS assessment.

Enrollment: Students remain in the Transitional Program of Instruction for three years or until they reach proficiency in academic English.

Assessment: Proficiency level is measured using ACCESS test, which is an assessment given in January. Families are informed of the results when they are available in May.

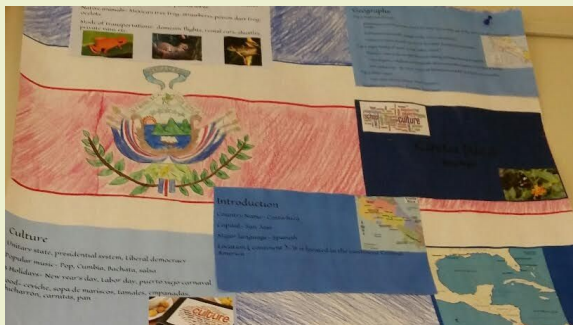
Information

English Language support is state mandated

Parents can refuse the support **however**, the only way the student exits the status is through achieving current qualifying exit scores on ACCESS (4.8 or higher Composite score)

Even when EL refuses the support he/she is required to take ACCESS administered in January

Support varies each year. It is developed to address the most current needs of the students based on most recent ACCESS test results.
